SHARES HER STORY IN A CHILDREN'S BOOK

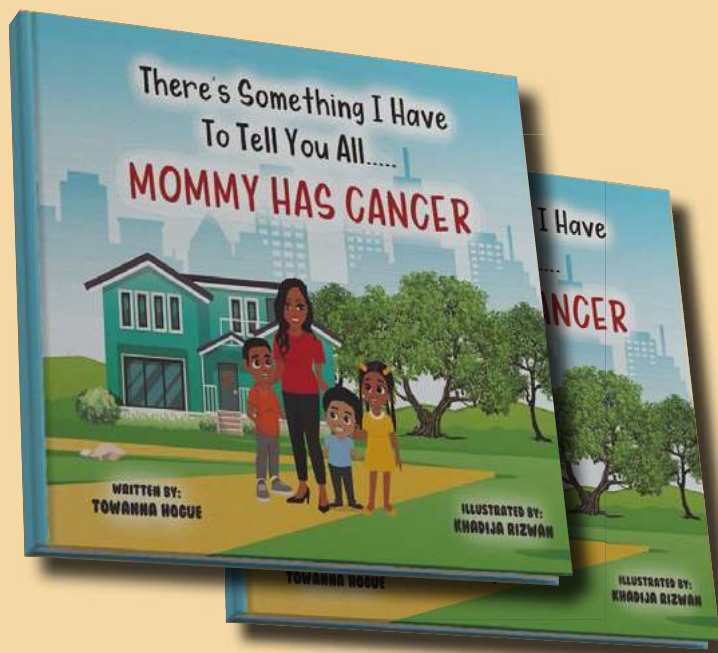
Accomplished writer and survivor Towanna Hogue talks about her debut children's book titled *"There's Something I Have To Tell You All... Mommy Has Cancer."*
